Dear Members,

We discussed and agreed at the 2016 AGM that the Club would apply for a key to gain access to the top car park on Ben Nevis. This parking allows easier access to the north face and can save a good chunk of time especially with heavy packs and tired legs.

As a club we now have an access key from the Forestry Commission along with a laminated pass and this can be used by one vehicle to gain access through the locked barrier. We have the key for a year at a cost of £250 to the club and we will review how often the key has been used at next years AGM and whether we renew the permission.

Any club member can request use of the key subject to :-

- Cost to each car wishing to use the key will be £10
- To obtain the key contact myself (see the contacts page on the website: <http://www.edinburghmc.org.uk/emc/contacts>) or any committee member, please give as much notice as possible
- You must abide by the rules set out by the Forestry Commission (a copy of these will be given to you along with the key and laminated pass)
- Permission for the key expires on 5th June 2017

This is the first time the club has obtained this access so we'd encourage members to make use of it as much as possible.
